CIVIL SOCIETY

1. Mobilisation of resources both human and financial/diversifying sources of funding
2. Spearheading a massive go back to school campaign in areas where children have not returned to school
3. Mapping out recovery efforts to avoid duplication
4. Training of teachers and educators on Conflict Resolution, Peace building, and guidance & counselling
5. Intensifying community peace education campaigns through seminars, workshops especially for out of school youths
6. Intensifying community and school peace education campaigns
7. Promoting conflict sensitive community based identification and monitoring programmes
8. Lobbying and advocating for legislative and policy reforms
9. Collaboration with the media to preach peace education
10. Continuous sharing of plans, progress and all other relevant reports with GoK
11. Carrying out complementary activities required to increase probability of success
12. Provide additional support to infrastructure development/reconstruction efforts
